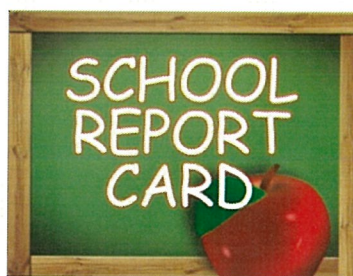
STAFFING CHANGES

We celebrated Early Stage 1, Stage 1, Stage 2 and Stage 3 Presentation and Year 6 Graduation events this week.

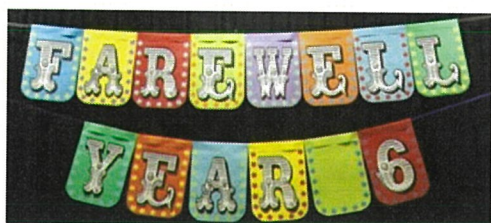
Congratulations to all students who received their Super Student Awards and medallions.

SKOOLBAG APP



Our SkoolBag app can be downloaded through the App Store and Google play. The app allows the school to send out alerts and reminders to the whole school as well as individual grades. The app has many features including school calendar, notes, sports days, assembly days, e-forms (to notify the school if your child was absent), links to our canteen and uniform shop for online ordering and price lists, P&C information including our sponsors plus much more. You can set up push notifications to alert you for your child's grade.

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
