Hobbies/Interests: My hobbies and interests including drawing, cricket, soccer and playing video games.

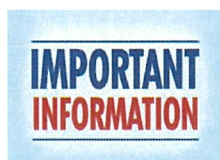
What do you bring to the school in your leadership role? I bring kindness and to uphold the school values by being a safe respectful learner and set an example for the younger students.
